GENERAL:

The Cardamom Planters' Association College affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University started functioning from 1974. It has a significant part to play in providing collegiate education to the students of this educationally backward area. It is an institution under the Cardamom Planters' Association, Bodinayakanur. The College is co-educational, it is non-communal and non-sectarian. It offers a well integrated scheme of formal instruction, mentor system and personal guidance. It prepares the students for various opportunities in the areas of higher education and rural uplift.

SAILENT FEATURES :

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FEE CONCESSIONS

Grant of scholarship from Government of India or State Government will be admissible to the students only when sanction orders are issued by appropriate authorities. The college is not responsible for the grant or non-grant of Government scholarships. All students are expected to pay their dues to college and hostel until sanction orders are issued by the authorities.

Scholarships and fee concession are awarded by the Government of India, Government of Tamil Nadu and other bodies to students of decided ability and to those who are unable to continue their studies without financial help, on the basis of the results of Higher Secondary Examination.

Scholarships are awarded in all eligible post-matric students belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and to deserving and meritorious candidates from other backward classes. Scholars who were awarded this scholarship the previous year and who are now pursuing a continuous course of study or passing the last annual examination are also eligible.

1. Adi Dravidar Welfare Department Scholarship

Students belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other eligible communities and backward class of Tamil Nadu whose pecuniary circumstances are certified to be such as to prevent them from prosecuting their studies without the assistance of scholarship are granted scholarship by the Adi Dravidar Welfare Officer, Theni and District backward class welfare officer, Theni.

There is no income limit in the case of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes and in the case of other backward classes annual income should not exceed Rs.2,00,000/-.

Most backward classes and denotified tribes scholarships are sanctioned by the *District, Backward Class welfare Officer*, Theni. Free education - No income limit upto Rs.1,00,000/-.

2. Merit Scholarship (National Scholarships)

Scholarships are awarded to deserving students by the Director or Collegiate Education, Tamil Nadu on the basis of the marks / grade (60%) obtained by them at the previous examination. Parents' income imposes no limit.

3. Government of India Scholarships to children of political sufferers

Residential and non-residential scholarship are awarded by the Director of Collegiate Education to the children, stepchildren and grandchildren of political sufferers and children of persons who participated in the Indian national Army(INA). Movement studying in Arts and Training colleges. The entire annual income of the family of the political sufferer or the guardian including the applicant's from all sources should not exceed Rs.2,00,000 /-.

4. Fee Concession

As per rule 92 Tamil Nadu Educational Rules (TNER) students of B.A., B.Sc., & B.Com., classes belonging to eligible communities - Most backward classes and backward classes are eligible for half - fee concession, provided that annual income of the parent or guardian of the student does not exceed Rs. 50,000 /-. Students of B.A., B.Sc., & B.Com., classes belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes including converts to christianity are also eligible for full fee concession. There is no income limit for the above communities. Students who belong to the above classes must submit a certificate from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of a Deputy Thasildar.

5. Kallar Reclamation Scholarship (for Piramalai Kallar students only)

Apply to the Special Deputy Collector, Kallar Reclamation, Theni. (Free Education - No income limit)

6. Fee concession for the dependents of serving Defence personnel

Scholarship and concession for children of Defence Service personnel who serve in operational areas and in active service in Defence Department are allowed.

7. Government of India Scholarship

Eligible for the orthopedically handicapped. Apply to the Director of social welfare, 485, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai - 600 035.

8. National Loan Scholarship

The government of India has instituted the national loan scholarship scheme with the main object of providing financial assistance to the needy and meritorious students to complete their studies. They must have secured not less than 50% of marks in the qualifying examination. The annual income of the parent or guardian should not exceed Rs.2,00,000/-. Apply to the Director of Collegiate Education, Chennai.

9. Students Aid Fund

The object of this fund will be to render financial aid to poor students to meet their tuition or examination fees or to purchase books and similar other expenses. No scholarship or stipend will be given from this fund.

10. E.V.R. Nagammai Free Education

Eligible for backward classes first year lady students. Income of parents should not exceed Rs.50,000/- per year.

12. Pudumai Peen

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K Stalin has launched the Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Higher Education Assurance scheme titled “ pudhumai Penn”

Girl Students who studied form Class VI to XII in state government schools would be paid monthly assistance of Rs.1000/- till they complete the year graduation or diploma under this scheme.

12. Tamil Pudhalvan Scheme

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K Stalin has launched the Tamil Pudhalvan Higher Education Assurance scheme titled “ Tamil Pudhalvan scheme”

ADMISSION :

Application for admission to the college should be made through online only. Separate application form should be used for each major.

- 1) The payment of the registration fee does not guarantee a seat but only for the consideration of the application. The registration fee will not be refunded under any circumstances. No preference is given to applicants merely for the reason that they have applied early.
- 2) The duly filled-in application form for admission should be accompanied by all the necessary certificates mentioned therein.
- 3) If the applicant is the son daughter of ex-serviceman, he / she should produce a relevant certificate (6 seats are reserved for wards of ex-serviceman)
- 4) If the parent is a member of C.P.Association, a certificate from the C.P.Association should be enclosed.
- 5) If the applicant is Differently abled he / she should enclose a certificate from a medical officer (3 seats are reserved for differently abled)
- 6) Application with insufficient or incomplete particulars will not be considered.
- 7) A list of the names of the students provisionally selected for admission will be put up on the college notice board.

- 8) Applicants will receive letter intimating provisional selection only. Final selection will be made only after an interview with the Head of the Department concerned and with the Principal.
- 9) Applicants selected for interview will have to meet the Principal in person. Parents / Guardians who take complete responsibility for the education of the applicants shall also accompany them for the interview. Applicants not accompanied by parent will not be granted interview.
- 10) An applicant who fails to represent himself / herself at the interview on the appointed day will forfeit his / her chance/selection.
- 11) Candidates selected provisionally should produce the following certificates in **ORIGINAL** at the time of interview.
 - a) H.Sc., First and second year mark statements for UG Admission. *For PG admission, UG course All 5 semester mark statements,*
 - b) Transfer Certificate,
 - c) Conduct certificate issued by the Head of the institution,
 - d) Community certificate in the case of BC / MBC / DNC / SC / ST applicant obtained from a Revenue officer not below the rank of a Deputy Tahsildar.
- 12) Candidates finally selected will be admitted on payment of the prescribed fees for the first semester in full. Selected candidates who fail to pay the fees within the prescribed date will forfeit their seats. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- 13) At the time of admission, the candidate should submit the following certificates in original and three sets of attested photocopies.
 - a) Transfer Certificate
 - b) H.Sc., First and Second year / U.G course mark sheets
 - c) Community certificate
 - d) Attendance Certificate obtained from the institution last studied.
 - e) For students belongs to other than Madurai Kamaraj University should produce the eligibility certificate obtained from the Madurai Kamaraj University.
 - f) The applicant should give 3 passport size photographs and 3 duly stamped self – addressed envelopes at the time of admission.
 - g) First Graduate Certificate
 - h) Govt. School studied certificate (from 6th to 12th std)
 - i) EMIS ID
 - j) Bank Account Front Page
- 14) The Principal reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate without assigning any reason whatsoever. Should there be any material discrepancy between the certificates and entries in the application or should any suppression of facts be discovered, such candidate will be summarily dismissed with forfeiture of all fees paid by him / her.
- 15) It should be clearly understood that all admissions are made subject to the relevant regulation of the Madurai Kamaraj University , Madurai / Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai.
- 16) As per the government order, admission is subject to verification of mark statements by the Director of Government Examinations and if the mark statement is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation, besides criminal action being taken.
- 17) Scholarship shall be sanctioned subject to 90% attendance of the students.
- 18) Financial aids are available to students with merit and promise besides Government Scholarship and fee concessions under 92 TNET.
- 19) If there is any grievance in the matter of admission, it may be brought to the notice of the Joint Director of Collegiate Education, Madurai.
- 20) College buses are available only for all girl students.
